COMPANY HISTORY


Gason is a significant employer in the Ararat region that is active in training apprentices and encourages personal development for all staff.

Cert III Engineering and Fabrication is offered upon completion of your apprenticeship.

Gason apprenticeships encompass practical hands-on learning delivered by trained and experienced tradespeople, giving you valuable industry experience and a nationally recognised qualification.

Courses are tailored to each apprentice and generally take 3 to 4 years to complete, depending on the workload you undertake and any additional electives you choose. Your apprenticeship will cover three areas of competency to nurture the skills necessary for your success:

Foundation Competencies lay out principles relating to metals and engineering industry standards.

Core Competencies cover common activities and positions associated with the metal/ engineering industry.



Elective Competencies give you a range of skills personalised to your unique learning experience.

The program ensures graduates are trained in important skills such as:

- · Competency in MIG & TIG welding
- · Quality assurance systems
